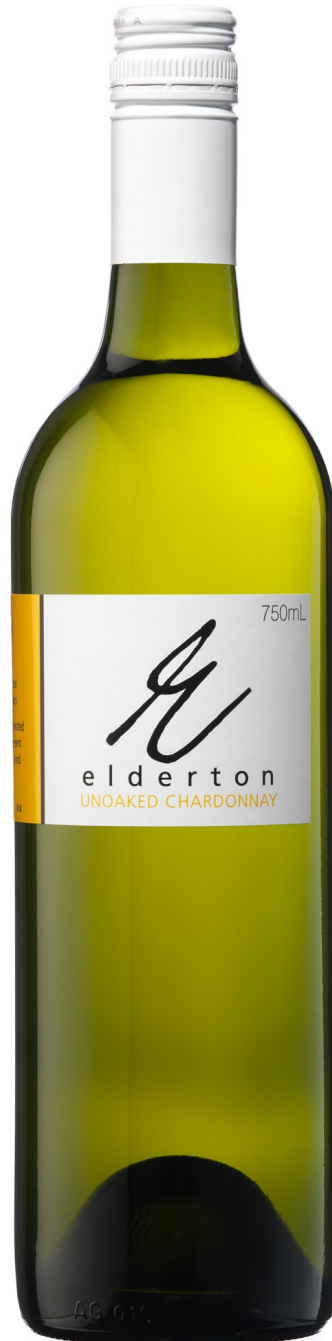
E is for **Environment**
